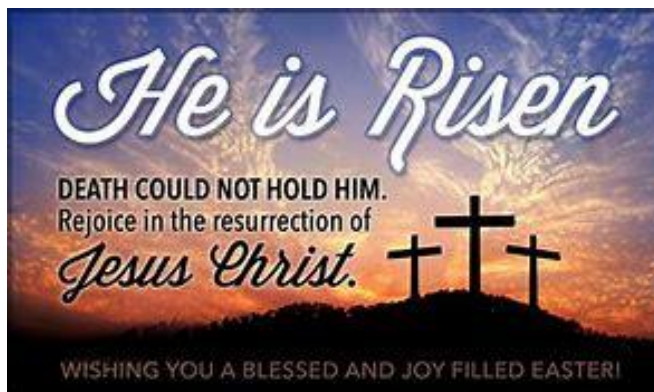

How does Habitat for Humanity homeownership work?

Are Habitat for Humanity houses free?
Families in need of decent, affordable housing apply for homeownership with their local Habitat for Humanity. Each local Habitat's family selection committee selects homeowners based on three criteria:

- Prospective Habitat homeowners must demonstrate a need for safe, affordable housing.
- Once selected, Habitat homeowners must partner with us throughout the process. This partnership includes performing "sweat equity," or helping to build their own home or the homes of others in our homeownership program. Sweat equity can also include taking homeownership classes.
- Homeowners must also be able and willing to pay an affordable mortgage. Mortgage payments are cycled back into the community to help build additional Habitat houses.

Habitat for Humanity of North Augusta follows a nondiscriminatory policy of family selection. Neither race nor religion are a factor in choosing Habitat's homeowners.

We are a global nonprofit, ecumenical Christian housing organization. All who desire to be a part of this work are welcome, regardless of religious preference or background. We have a policy of building with people in need regardless of race or religion. We welcome volunteers and supporters from all backgrounds.
